

håkan P110 pop killer



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS for INV-7HG-V and INV-7HG-H versions

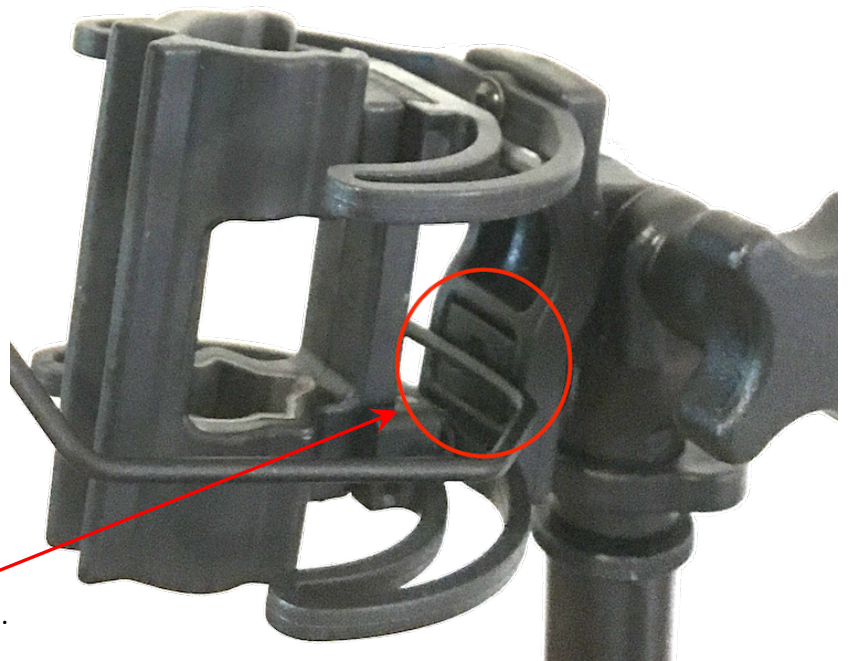
The Håkan P110 INV-7HG-V (vertical) and INV-7HG-H (horizontal) versions were designed specifically for use with the Rycote INV-7-HG III lyre shockmount.

The INV-7HG-V (vertical) version is designed for a side-address microphone such as the Microtech Gefell UMT 70S, MT 71S and similar sized side-address microphones. The INV-7HG-H (horizontal) version was designed for use with an end-address small diaphragm condenser microphone, or dynamic microphone of similar size.

The Pop Killers are delivered complete with a rectangular washer with a captive bolt and an Allen key for fixing.



The Pop Killer is fitted to the INV-7HG III by inserting the rectangular nut (which is an integral part of the Pop Killer) into the rectangular hole on the shockmount – see the circled area in the close-up photo on the right. (This shows the V version, the H version is similar).



The Pop Killer is then securely attached by screwing in the bolt with washer from the bottom side of the shockmount.

NB: there are two ways of mounting the INV-7HG-V (vertical) version – as illustrated, the pop filter is close to the end of the microphone clip. If the INV-7HG-V is turned around and fitted from the other side of the clip, the pop filter will be further away from the clip. Please fit in the way that suits the microphone you are using best.
