important, to have impact and be memorable.


New Logo for Sound-Link

Also on show will be the Håkan P110 Pop Killer.


Also on the stand will be Schulze-Brakel custom foam windshields.

Software version 1.7 for the AETA 4MinX is now available and can be downloaded from the AETA website. The new firmware adds flexibility and fixes some bugs. Midi control via some external devices is now added, as well as B-format Soundfield monitoring being added to the A-format monitoring alraeady available in the "Soundfield"

option. There is also an easier option of switching the 4MinX off or putting it to sleep.

Copy the downloaded file on to an SD card, insert the SD card into the 4MinX and select "Tools", "Update firmware"

There is also a new updated manual for the 4MinX available for download.


