
Pool Room at Pinewood Film Studios on Tuesday 24th September, where up to 150 sound professionals from Film, TV, Music

Firmware update for AETA 4MinX



Ability to change the audio settings directly from the windows that show the audio configuration of the MIC, LINES and AES inputs at a glance.

New window that shows the routing configuration of the mix-down and auxiliary buses at a glance; ability to change the audio routing directly from said window.

Fix the recorder that, in some cases, does not flush all remaining audio samples at the end of the files.

Copy the downloaded file on to an SD card, insert the SD card into the 4MinX and select "Tools", "Update firmware"

The current monitoring configuration of the player remains unchanged when navigating through takes, re-entering the player again.

Fix the player so the full duration of the audio files is played back; improve the handling of the pause, backward and forward actions.

Improve formatting of SD card / USB stick.




